- Introduced the comprehensive Students' Union Bulletin.





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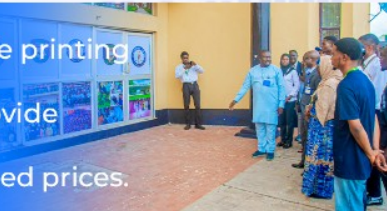
HEALTH, SAFETY & SOCIAL IMPACT
